A maximum of 6 credits which is taken by the students from other master programs of KNU can be included in 21 credits of professional elective courses. 2. The students graduate from this session must finish the master's thesis (not included in the 35 credits of coursework) and pass the oral examination. 3. Academic Ethics is required course with 0 credit. The students can apply the oral examination after taking this course online and pass the examination. 4.
